CHESHVAN is the eighth month of the Jewish calendar. The Number "8" is eternal revelation and new beginning and is linked with the tribe of Manasseh. Manasseh means "to forget, to leap, up and away." Let God renew you body, soul and spirit like Joseph.

UNDERSTANDING THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID

Throughout the Scriptures, God made clear His intent to 'dwell among us' from the Garden to the Wilderness to settling Israel in Jerusalem. God did all He could to live among us. Jesus became the Word made flesh and dwelt among us. He ascended and sent Holy Spirit to empower us to be His witnesses and to live and dwell in us.

MAKE KNOWN MY WORKS FROM ETERNITY

The Tabernacle of David was a future expectation of God to dwell among His people, Jews and Gentiles. The future is simply God's **expected end** that He has not gotten to yet. It's a process and we cannot stop midway. The Lord knows our future, we just need to keep on moving forward into God's intended end for us. The verses in Amos and Acts is God's Promise Extended, like when Hezekiah's life was extended, 2 Kings 20. We are part of the Promise Extended.

THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID WILL BE RESTORED

When King David restored the ark back into Jerusalem. He first tried to do it with strength of numbers and place it on an ox pulled cart. That effort failed. Then he got the priests whose duty it was to carry the ark to bear it on their shoulders and just to make sure, he made a sacrifice every six steps until it was safely in Jerusalem. That was a bloody road to the restoration of God's presence in our lives. Jesus paid with His own blood to restore our fellowship back to the Father!

ASCEND IN WORSHIP; DESCEND IN WAR

We cannot ascend and descend if we don't understand that the Lord has rebuilt the Tabernacle of David among us. We are a Kingdom people and we have a Kingdom position and we exercise Kingdom authority to live in the first heaven, push through the second heaven by the blood of Jesus and come boldly before the throne of God in the third heaven. We are meant to do this as a tribe, an army.
